Since 1966 How Hill, the environmental study centre for the Broads, has been providing a unique introduction to this wonderful environment for thousands of children and adults every year.

Generations of families have fond memories of visiting How Hill, inspiring a lifetime love of the Broads and nature.

Last year (2015), we welcomed 2,894 children from 42 schools who stayed with us, and 1,338 children from 28 schools who came on day visits. 85% of school children visiting are from Norfolk schools.

The children who stay benefit from increased social and life skills. For many it is their first time away from home, they share bedrooms, eat together, experience the darkness and quietness of the rural Norfolk Broads and they are encouraged to think for themselves and interact with others.
