## One winning photograph will be selected for each season.

**Spring Photographs:** Closing date for submission of photographs is 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020. Winners will be notified by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

**Summer Photographs:** Closing date for submission of photographs is 30<sup>th</sup> September. Winners will be notified by 31<sup>st</sup> October.

**Autumn Photographs:** Closing date for submission of photographs is 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Winners will be notified by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020.

**Winter Photographs:** Closing date for submission of photographs is 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021. Winners will be notified by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

- No photographs of visiting school groups may be taken under any circumstances.
- Entry to the competition is free and open to everyone except How Hill Trust employees.
- Entry into the competition is acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- Entries must be in digital format only no prints or slides will be accepted.
- Entries must be JPEG files and be the best quality available. Minimum file size 4 MB.
- Entries must be free from text and photographer's watermarks.
- Your details will not be passed on to any third party without your permission.
- All photographs submitted must be the work of the individual who submits them. Entrants must ensure that photographs have been taken with the permission of the subject (where necessary) and do not infringe the copyright of any third party.
- By submitting a photograph to this Competition entrants agree that How Hill Trust reserves the right to free reproduction and exhibition of the image in all media to promote the Trust's work. Photographers will be credited if an image is used, where possible. The copyright of photographs remains with the photographer.
- All images must be taken at How Hill, or on the River Ant nearby, including Barton Broad. Images of wildlife must be taken in the natural environment.
- Digital adjustments are acceptable; the way in which any digital enhancement or editing has been used will be taken into account when judging the entry. However, major changes of content are not allowed.
- Judges appointed by How Hill Trust will choose the winning images. Their decision is final.
